2004 Photos

The bungalow in the garden, built in the 1930's, was demolished in 2009 and the ground on which it stood used by the builders for their site offices.





2010 Infrastructure Work

In February 2010, the contractors, South West Highways, began work on the infrastructure of the garden – clearing the brambles, felling dead and diseased trees, contouring the ground, laying paths, and constructing the cascades and pools.
