#### Leechwell Garden - Community Spaces Grant Application

Further to my letter dated 29<sup>th</sup> March, I am writing to confirm a number of additional enquires on behalf of South Hams District Council (SHDC) in relation to supporting the Leechwell Garden Association's Community Spaces application. The project involves the creation of specific, community led, garden improvements and delivery of an informal natural play space.

The play space will also be scheduled for an Annual Inspection and as a minimum, monthly Operational Inspections. Any maintenance or repair will be undertaken by the District Council or relevant qualified craftsman.
- All Community operations and activities will be agreed and accord with the District's relevant documentation on Risk Management, and Health and Safety requirements.
