2. PREVIOUS MINUTES: the minutes of the last meeting, on 1st March 2022, were approved.

MATTERS ARISING

CCTV: Following the assault on the Mayor on March 20th, there is a plan to raise the height of the street light in the footpath (near the Herb Garden) and install a CCTV camera on it.

Totnes Directory: Sue thanked David and Philip for their efforts, noting that several people, having read it, commented that they had not realised the garden was looked after by LGA volunteers rather than the council. Robert suggested putting a QR code in the next edition, directing people to the FaceBook or Instagram pages.

ParkLife funding for dealing the 'meadows': Sue would check with Keith to see if they were being funded to do this.

3. 2022 PLAN UPDATE

Sue handed out a document detailing the work that had been carried out since Autumn 2021 (attached). She also showed her colour-coded plan of garden areas (see below). Dave noted that he intended to try to update the garden plan produced by Charlotte Rathbone back in 2009 which is now hopelessly out of date.

Sue also noted that the boggy area above the waterfall (due to a leak from the pool) is now quite dangerous but is also very popular with children who use the area above as a sort of den. We need to decide whether to make it inaccessible or safe. Fixing the leak will have to be done without touching the pool (because it's a scheduled ancient monument) – it might be possible to install a French drain to deal with the outflow.

4. PROJECTS

Sue noted performance of "Midsummer's Night Dream" in the garden just before r the May half-term) organized by Helen Sands and the garden party to take place on August 18-19 as part of the Totnes and Bridgetown Festival or Arts and Culture (see https://www.visittotnes.co.uk/whats-on/totnes-and-bridgetown-festival-of-arts-and-culture-2022/).

5. MAINTENANCE

6. SHDC

We need to ensure that SHDC do the tasks they have agreed to (schedule set up by Keith). So far they have not mowed/cut the grass.
