### **Garden Preparations:**

Keith will arrange for the grass to be cut a week before the opening - including the new turf, so the Ops Team will need to bring a spanner! The Sand Pit notice has now been agreed and will be fixed to a low post near the sand pit. The SHDC/Allianz insurance inspection is due this week and should not cause any problems.

#### **Closing the Garden:**

The garden will be closed from noon until 3pm to allow Earth Wrights to remove the fencing and the LGA to set up a gazebo and table and put tape and ribbon around the play structure. Keith will get SHDC's permission for the closure.
